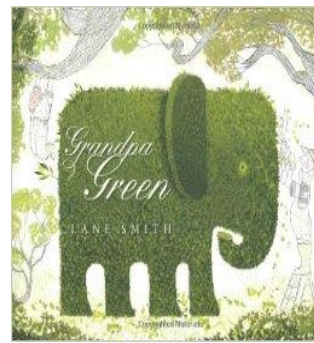
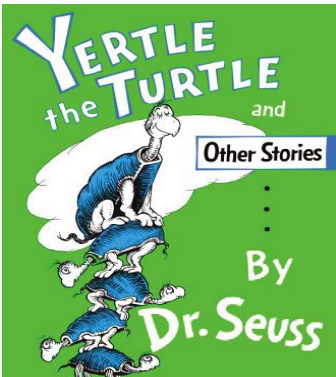


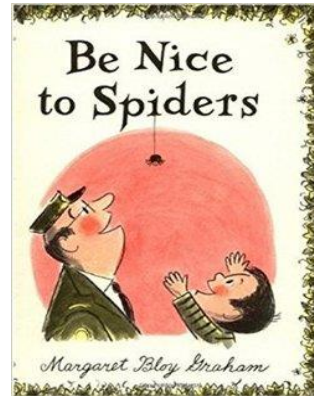
Best for Ages: 6-10 years

 The first thing I appreciated about this work was the mixed media illustrations, but it was certainly not the last! You won't regret taking the time for this one.



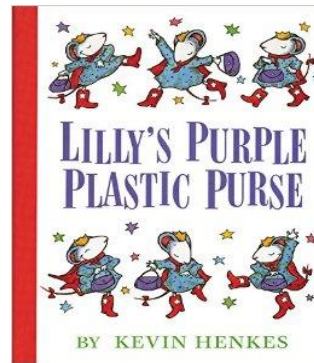
Best for Ages: 5+ years
 This is one of my favorite Seuss books, each story fun and told humorously, with a solid moral in each. I find works like this are the best way to instill values in young people easily.



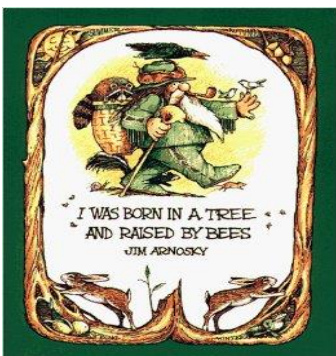
Best for Ages: 6+ years

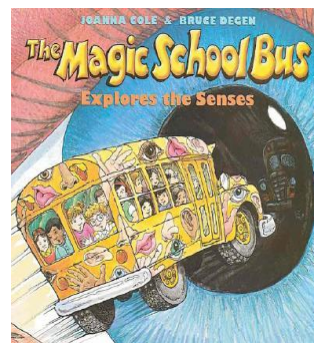
Best for Ages: 5+ years
 Every parent can expect, at some point, eventually, dealing with head lice. When that day comes, brighten your day with a lice removal kit, and this book!



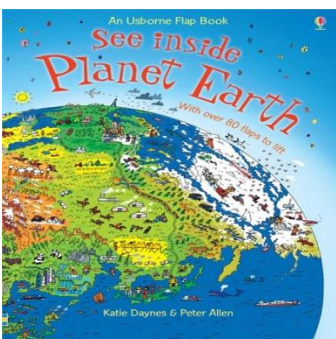
Best for Ages: 5-8 years
 This book spoke right to my heart, because I was once a little girl much like Lilly. Henke's never fails to impress his readers, both with his voice and his pictures. Don't miss it!



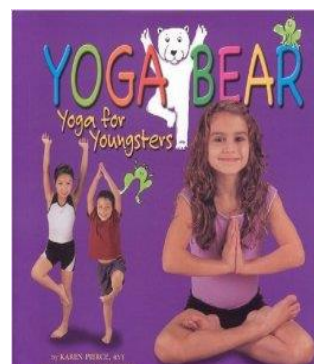
Best for Ages: 6 years +
 Crinkleroot is SUCH a great guide in the woods! This book is one of the best to read with young kids who have a lot of questions about the natural world.



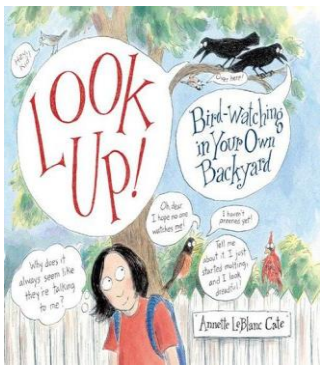
Best for Ages: 6 years +
 Like all Magic School Bus books, this book has basic text for younger readers, with plenty of marginal supplemental learning, so youngsters can get more out of each reading.



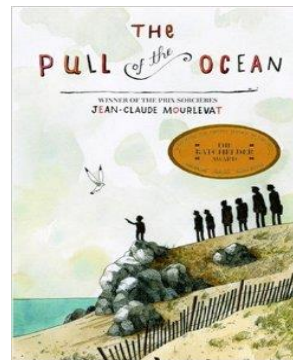
Best for Ages: 8 years+
 This book has SO much information in it, and yet remains pretty unintimidating to young readers due to its lift-the-flap format. The illustrations are perfect!



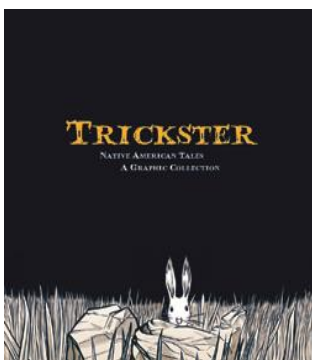
Best for Ages: 4-8 years
 Getting kids active in the summertime is good for their minds and bodies. Don't forget the importance of stretching! This book has a variety of easy poses, with parents' information included.



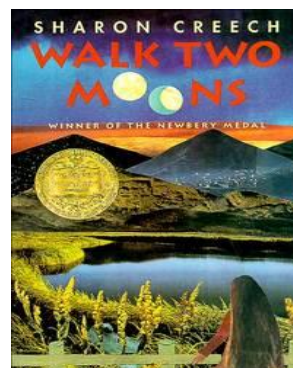
Best for Ages: 6-12 years
