



# **R.S.U. 1 Reads!**

## **Teen Summer Reading Program 2019**

*June 19<sup>th</sup> – August 28<sup>th</sup>*

The teachers and staff of R.S.U. 1 and Patten Free Library invite all students who are entering grades 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> at a R.S.U. 1 school (or who are residing in the library service area) to embark on another summer of reading and learning. Here is how this year's program works:

- 1.) On the last day of school, begin **any** reading or learning activity from the list on the reverse.
- 2.) When you finish an activity, record the details on the attached log.
- 3.) Then...begin another. Your R.S.U. 1 teachers suggest that you read **at least two books over the summer**, so make sure at least two of your twenty activities involve finishing a book.
- 4.) Anytime between June 19<sup>th</sup> and August 28<sup>th</sup>, stop by the Information Desk at Patten Free Library, and show the librarians your log (and your creations, your written work, or pictures of your completed activities). For every book or activity that you complete (up to 20), you can choose either a "Bath Buck" redeemable at a local business or a free book. For every 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>th</sup> activity, you'll receive a scratch ticket for a larger prize donated by a local business.
- 5.) As a bonus, if you complete **all** twenty activities listed on the reverse, you will be eligible for a jackpot drawing.

The librarians at the Information Desk at Patten Free Library have resources to help you with all of these activities, including: assigned school reading lists, poetry books, cookbooks, lists of books adapted to movies, lists of award-winning books, maker boxes, local concert listings, maps of Bath's historic markers, maps of local nature preserves, and more.

Write a letter to a favorite author.

Visit all the historic markers around Bath.

Attend a play or concert (*anywhere!*).

Read *Treasure Island*.

Complete the PFL letterbox challenge.

Re-read a favorite book.

Visit a nature preserve.
